HOW ARE WE RESPONDING TO THE LEARNING FROM OUR MULTI-AGENCY AUDITS?



Learning and Development

- Summary slides are produced and disseminated following each multi-agency audit
- Guidance for professionals has been produced around involving children and young people in formal meetings which has been disseminated across the Partnership
- The learning from our neglect audit has informed the <u>neglect</u> <u>tiered knowledge framework</u> and the <u>neglect continuum of tools</u> including the <u>screening tool</u>
- A suite of tools to capture the voice of the child have been developed and have been trialled with a range of pupils in Solihull to ensure their effectiveness. They will be soon be available here.
- To encourage increased attendance at multi-agency training, the <u>SSCP Training Programme</u> has been developed and scheduled for the whole of 2024/25 to allow professionals to plan
- Guidance for professionals around capturing the voice of the child is being developed

Further assurance activity

- A further audit of neglect is scheduled for 2024/25 to measure the impact of the neglect continuum of tools.
- A dip sample will be completed to take a further look at Exploitation and the MAACE process.
- In 2024/25 audits will be completed on children on a Child in Need Plan, Childrens Mental Health and Sexual Abuse.

Alert the need for action and an appropriate response. Identify which agency / practitioner will progress with assessment or intervention as needed. Who can use the tool? The screening tool is intended to be used by practitioners from all agencies/	
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organisations/ disciplines across Solihull.	
It is applicable to all ages to help identify neglect and associated factors across all age ranges.	
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
