Regional Audits (S11 and Care Act Compliance)



A regional audit tool, which covers both the Section 11 duties and Care Act compliance requirements, is being launched across 10 local areas within the wider West Midlands.

What are the benefits of a regional tool?

This regional approach means that those partners who cover more than one local safeguarding children partnership/safeguarding adults board will be able to submit a single completed audit, as opposed to multiple audits. This approach therefore streamlines the process and reduces the workload for those partners. In addition, the tool is standardised and will allow for benchmarking of responses to compare across partnership areas, and to track trends over time.
