



# Learning from Multi-Agency Audits 2023/24

Throughout 23/24 the SSCP Audit Group completed 4 multi-agency audits, looking at the following themes: Neglect, Voice of the Child, Supervision and All Age Exploitation. **What we have learned in 2023/24 – SSCP Multi-Agency Audit Group**

**What do we want to do differently for our children and families in Solihull?**

- Information Sharing**  
Sharing of information in Solihull should be effective and timely. Doing so will help to ensure the multi-agency safeguarding response is proportionate and more beneficial to our children and families.
- Individual differences and intersectionality**  
We need to consider a Child's individual differences (ethnicity, disability etc.) more when understanding their lived experiences, ensuring an individual does not get 'lost' in a sibling group.
- Tools for practitioners and multi-agency training**  
We want to ensure our workforce are taking advantage of multi-agency training available to them to provide them with knowledge and skills enhance their work with children and families. We would also like to ensure all professionals working with children and families in Solihull have access to the necessary tools to help the families they work with whether they be screening tools or tools to capture the voice of the child.
- Involving children in multi-agency meetings**  
Where appropriate, we want children to be aware of why services are involved with them and empower them to take part in multi-agency meetings by being present and having their say. This includes offering advocacy.

## SSCP Training 2024-25
