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Restorative Practice Briefing Sessions



Solihull Children's Services are transforming their culture, practice and services for children through restorative practice. This focuses on building strong, meaningful, and respectful high challenge, high support relationships with a focus on personal responsibility and an emphasises on the importance of doing things *with* people rather than *to* or *for* them.

Solihull Parenting Team - Autumn Term

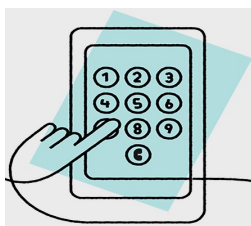
The Solihull Parenting Team have shared their timetable for the Autumn Term, dates can be found [here](#).
